There will be no assigned seating for choruses this year. Seating is open.

Quartet Love Gift Bags

The Assisting Chorus will be providing bags for Quartet Love Gifts at Thursday night's Briefing. Quartets who would like to give cards or little gifts to their fellow competitors should arrive at least 15 minutes before the Briefing to put them in the bags. Please note that there are NOT Love Gift bags for choruses.

Chorus Riser Chairs and Props

If you are planning to use a riser chair or props during your performance, you must bring them to the backstage area on FRIDAY morning between 8–10am. Chairs and props may not be dropped off on Saturday. Please be sure chairs and props are labeled with chorus name.

Pattern Guides - Briefing on Thursday

NOTE: We have retired the term, "hostesses." They are now called Pattern Guides.

If your Chorus or Quartet wishes to have a personal Pattern Guide to accompany you through the entire pattern, you must provide one of your own (it could be a member of your chorus, a sister, a husband, a coach, etc.).

If you choose this option, please complete the Needs Assessment Form and return it by March 1. It is imperative that your guide be notified of the time/place of the Thursday Night Briefing, which they MUST attend.

Returning 2023 Trophies

If your chorus or quartet earned a traveling trophy or plaque at our 2023 Convention, it is time to bring them back so they can be presented to this year's winner!

Withdrawing from Contest

In the event your chorus or quartet needs to withdraw from the contest prior to the weekend, you must email Music Services at International Headquaters. They will notify the region of your withdrawal. If you must withdraw once the weekend begins, please contact the Region 11 Competition Coordinator ASAP (Tina Rowley).

OPEN DIVISION Competitors

If you are planning to use props, <u>you must bring</u> them to the backstage area on FRIDAY morning between 8–10am. Props may not be dropped off on Saturday morning. Props not delivered on Friday must be carried with you through the pattern.

There will be a microphone on a stand stage left and stage right, in addition to the microphones at center stage. Contestants can take the stand mics off the stands, but must return them to the stand(s) before leaving the stage.
