\*NOTE: If you are a dual member of both Region 11 and Region 21, you have already paid for your AET with your Region 11 dues. You must register for your AET with Region 11 to avoid paying for another AET.

Single Event Tickets (SETs) can continue to be purchased after March 14 and will be available for purchase ONLINE ONLY during the Convention weekend. Just scan the QR code at registration.

New this year – To distinguish SETs from AETs, color-coded wristbands will be distributed for each day...one color for Friday and a different color for Saturday. Show your SET purchase receipt at registration to get the right color.

#### Sunday's Chat With the Judges

This fun and informative event is a lovely way to wrap up the weekend. Judges will be available to discuss the criteria in their categories, how they judge a contestant, specifics of the levels, and any trends they are seeing. *Please note: This is not a discussion of personal scoresheets or evaluations.* 

#### Withdrawals from Contest

If your chorus or quartet has to withdraw, you must send an email to International Headquarters (jordan@sweetadelines.com) and our Competition Coordinator Lou Gordon (competitioncoordinator@region21.org). A phone call is not sufficient. Should you need to withdraw on competition weekend, please call or text Lou Gordon ASAP at 480-375-8362.

#### **Riser Configurations**

Choruses will be on a standard set of risers (9 sets with inverted center) on the carpeted, flat ballroom floor. (Quartets will be on a small stage.) *Choruses and quartets will enter from stage right and exit stage left.* 

#### **OPEN DIVISION Competitors**

If you are planning to use props, <u>you</u> <u>must bring them to the backstage area</u> <u>on FRIDAY morning between 8–10am</u>. Props may not be brought on Saturday morning. Props not delivered on Friday must be carried with you in the pattern.

There will be a microphone on a stand stage left and stage right, in addition to the microphones at center stage. Contestants can take the stand mics off the stands, but must return them to the stand(s) before leaving the stage.

#### **Chorus Riser Chairs and Props**

If you are planning to use a riser chair or props during your performance, <u>you</u> <u>must bring them to the backstage area</u> <u>on FRIDAY morning between 8–10am</u>. Chairs and props may not be dropped off on Saturday. Please be sure chairs and props are labeled with chorus name.

#### **Convention Center Seating**

There is no assigned seating – seating is open. The first few rows of the center section will be reserved for VIPs and their one guest. Please do not sit in this area unless VIP is indicated on your badge.

#### Photography

Photos will be taken in the Marriott Lighthouse Room <u>before</u> your contest performance.

All photos will be distributed as **digital files only**.

- Choruses pay \$5/person based on the number of members estimated to be on stage. Choruses may either collect \$5 from every member or pay for it from their chorus treasury. Please plan for 1 or 2 poses only.
- Quartets will pay \$20. Please plan ahead for 2 or 3 poses only.

Choruses and quartets have the option to opt out, meaning you will not receive any photos. However, SAI requires that all competitors have an official photo taken. This includes those competing for Evaluation or in the Open Division.

In 2-3 weeks, you'll receive high-res, retouched files of all your poses! You can then distribute them to your members and upload them to social media! And members can take a file to a place near them to have it printed, if desired.

NO photographs or videos are allowed from any audience member during the competition, unless authorized by Sweet Adelines International.

#### **SMALL Purses in the Pattern**

All Quartet and Chorus competitors – your personal items MUST t in a small purse (size of a quart-size Ziplock bag). If you need more than that once you get into the auditorium, please make arrangements ahead of time for someone in the audience to hold your things for you.



Choruses will receive large shopping bags after your photo– all purses will be placed backstage before your chorus takes the stage on Saturday. These large shopping bags will get VERY heavy with all the purses, so please be respectful of this policy.

#### Club 21 Jamboree

Club 21 – Region 21's Association of Quartet Champions – will hold a fun show at 7:30p on Thursday night in the Marriott Lighthouse Room. All Region 21 quartets are invited to perform one song (must not be part of their contest set).

Tickets are \$10. Money raised at this event is split between quartets representing Region 21 at International in Columbus, OH later this year.

Please bring the trophies and/or plaques to the ballroom on Thursday afternoon or on Friday morning at 8:00a. Be sure your trophy is polished and has been engraved with your name.

#### **Quartet Love Gift Bags**

Club 21 and Verdugo Hills Chorus will be providing Quartet Love Gift bags for those who would like to give cards or little gifts to their fellow competitors These bags will be located in the Registration area on Thursday during the day and during the Club 21 Jamboree on Thursday evening. Bags will then be distributed to the quartets at the walkthrough on Friday morning.

#### **Mic Testers**

Lucille – the 2025 International 4th Place Quartet medalists from Regions 21, 17 and 15 – will be our official mic testers.

#### **NEW! BarberTots Room!**

Have a fidgety child during the contest? Entertain them in the BarberTots Room, located in the Marriott Pier Room 1. The room will be equipped with a monitor and feed so you can still watch the contest. *PLEASE NOTE: Parents are responsible for accompanying their own child in the BarberTots Room – there will be no babysitters provided.* 

#### **Competition Recordings**

Within 24-48 hours after contest, the contact person for competing quartets and choruses will be emailed a login to download their video competition recording. Recordings may be shared on social media anytime after SAI publishes the official results, which is usually the Monday following the competition. There is no charge for these recordings.

#### **Mic Testing Chorus**

Lori Lyford invites anyone who would like to join in on the risers for Mic Testing on Friday morning. There will be a brief warmup at 8:30am and the inspection begins at 9:00am. #### Badges

To help with ongoing cost savings and to use best practices of reducing, reusing, and recycling, if you have badge holders at home, bring it with you – most of us have many badge holders collecting dust. Bring one with you and bring extra holders to share! Holders will be available at the registration table if needed.

Your badge is your ticket to all events and must be worn during the weekend. However, if you are a competitor and IN COSTUME, you do not need to have your badge.

#### Webcast

The first-ever joint regional contest will be available for friends and family to watch. Price is \$25, which gives webcast access to both competitions (quartets on Friday and choruses on Saturday).

An email with the password and instructions will be emailed prior to the competition.

The link and password sent to you are unique and cannot be shared. The technology and personnel required to produce a live broadcast are an extra cost above and beyond other recording expenses during competition. Please be considerate to your regions by not trying to give your friends free access.

Also, there will be no delayed viewing options to keep production costs down.
